



# A LESSON AT ADVENT: THE WISE MEN VISIT JESUS

## BEFORE YOU READ:

- During Advent, we learn all about God sending the world a special gift. That gift was Jesus!
- Before Jesus was born, special messengers of God, called prophets, told the people that Jesus was coming. Jesus was coming to save the world because it was broken due to sin.
- God chose earthly parents for Jesus. Their names were Mary and Joseph.
- The Roman emperor, Caesar Augustus announced that everyone needed to be counted. While obeying that order, the time came for Mary to have baby Jesus. Jesus was born where animals were, because there was no room in the inn for Mary and Joseph.
- Some months after Jesus was born, special visitors came from afar to worship him.

Read the following Bible Story to learn more!

## REVIEW/DISCUSS:

- Where were the Wise Men from? **(The east)** We actually don't know how many Wise Men there were, but they traveled from far away!
- How did the Wise Men know that Jesus had been born? **(They saw "his star" in the sky. That star guided them to Jesus)**
- Was King Herod happy or angry when he heard that Wise Men had come looking for Jesus to worship him? **(angry)**
- What did King Herod tell the Wise Men to do? **(Go search for the child and tell him as soon as they found Jesus)**
- What did Herod say he wanted to do? **(Worship Jesus)**
- Herod didn't really want to worship Jesus. Why did Jesus' birth as "King of the Jews" threaten Herod? **(Herod didn't want any other King to threaten his power, because he was the King.)**
- When the Wise Men found Jesus, what did they do? **(They bowed and worshipped Jesus)**
- What treasures did the Wise Men give to Jesus? **(Gold, Frankincense, and myrrh)**
- How did God warn the Wise Men not to go back to Herod? **(God warned them in a dream)**
- What does it mean to worship Jesus as King? How can you worship Jesus each and every day?



## PRAYER:

Dear God,  
You came to earth as a baby, but you were the King of Kings! Help me to worship you and give you my treasure, just like the Wise Men!

## READ: BIBLE STORY-MATTHEW 2

1. Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea. This happened while Herod was king of Judea. After Jesus' birth, Wise Men from the east came to Jerusalem.
2. They asked, "Where is the child who has been born to be king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose. Now we have come to worship him."
3. When King Herod heard about it, he was very upset. Everyone in Jerusalem was troubled too.
4. So Herod called together all the chief priests of the people. He also called the teachers of the law. He asked them where the Messiah was going to be born.
5. "In Bethlehem in Judea," they replied. "This is what the prophet has written. He said,
6. "' But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are certainly not the least important among the towns of Judah. A ruler will come out of you. He will rule my people Israel like a shepherd.'"
7. Then Herod secretly called for the Wise Men. He found out from them exactly when the star had appeared.
8. He sent them to Bethlehem. He said, "Go and search carefully for the child. As soon as you find him, report it to me. Then I can go and worship him too."
9. After the Wise Men had listened to the king, they went on their way. The star they had seen when it rose went ahead of them. It finally stopped over the place where the child was.
10. When they saw the star, they were filled with joy.
11. The Wise Men went to the house. There they saw the child with his mother Mary. They bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures. They gave him gold, frankincense and myrrh.
12. But God warned them in a dream not to go back to Herod. So they returned to their country on a different road.
